Region Riverina

> Appearance Straw with green hues.

Bouquet Aromas of passion-fruit and green apple.

Palate

Tropical. Soft and round with just enough acidity to keep palate fresh and lively.

Suggested Cuisine Seafood, roast chicken, goats cheese.

General Characteristics Dry / Medium bodied

Vintage Conditions

Good winter rains followed by a warm growing season lead to good yields of fruit. A hot beginning to the harvest period accelerated the ripening with frantic harvesting ensuing to pick the fruit with the ideal flavour spectrum.

Winemaking

89% of the fruit is from Riverina which give generosity of flavours. 11% is King Valley Sauvignon to give the wine some more punch and structure to the palate. Wine making techniques included fermentation at elevated temperatures and fermentation with solids. These techniques improve texture and softness without sacrificing varietal expression.
