This Pinot Blanc is a wine of our grape-selection line – a fresh and medium bodied white for almost every occasion.

Bassermann-Jordan is a family owned wine-estate producing for almost 300 years wines in Germany's well known wine-growing region "Pfalz" (Palatinate). The vines grow on the slopes of the Haardt mountain, the western brim of the Rhine-valley. The estate is situated in the town of Deidesheim, the historical and viticulture centre of the region.

Head-winemaker is Ulrich Mell, who led the wines and the reputation of the estate in the first row of German winemaking.

The vines are situated in our village of Deidesheim and its surroundings. The slopes are south-east facing and contain a lot of sandstone in the soil. The vines are in average 15 years old.

The 2014 Bassermann-Jordan Pinot Blanc dry is a young, fresh white. It has a bright and light colour. It is due to its youth very fresh and refreshing. Light notes of spring blossoms and apply notes are offered on the nose. On the palate the wine is upfront fruity and delicious. It is perfectly drunk on its own or in combination to starters and medium fish-dishes.

Enjoy it now or within the next 5-6 years!
